i. Glossary

Description	Definition		
Aida cloth	(Sometimes called Java canvas) is an open weave, even-weave fabric traditionally used for cross-stitch embroidery.		
Applique	A French word means "applied" or "thing that has been applied". Refers to a needlework technique in which patterns or representational scenes are created by the attachment of smaller pieces of fabric to a larger piece of contrasting colour or texture.		
Batting	Cotton, wool, or synthetic fiber wadded into rolls or sheets, used for stuffing furniture and mattresses and for lining quilts.		
Computerised Embroidery	Method of decorating fabric or other materials with computerised embroidery equipment.		
Cross stitch	A form of counted-thread embroidery in which X-shaped stitches in a tiled, raster-like pattern is used to form a picture.		
Embroidery	The handicraft of decorating fabric or other materials with needle and thread or yarn.		
Needlework	A broad term for the handicrafts of decorative sewing and textile arts. Anything that uses a needle for construction can be called needlework. The definition may expand to include related textile crafts such as a crochet hook or tatting shuttles.		
Paper piecing	This technique involves sewing pieces of fabric to a paper foundation following a numerical sequence.		
Patchwork	A form of needlework that involves sewing together pieces of fabric into a larger design. The larger design is usually based on repeat patterns built up with different fabric shapes (which can be different colours).		
Quilting	The process of sewing of two or more layers of fabric together to make a thicker padded material, usually to create a quilt or quilted garment.		
Redwork	Embroidery technique in which uses red floss to trace simple line drawings.		
Sashiko	A form of decorative reinforcement stitching (or functional embroidery) from Japan.		
Sewing notions	Sewing notions also known as basic sewing kit which may include the following items:- needles, pins, seam reaper, thimble, scissors, measuring tape, marking tools, pin cushion, etc.		
Smocking	An embroidery technique used to gather fabric so that it can stretch. Smocking was commonly used in cuffs, bodices, and necklines in garments where buttons were undesirable.		
Tatting	A technique for handcrafting a particularly durable lace from a series of knots and loops.		
Whitework	Embroidery technique in which the stitching is the same colour as the foundation fabric (traditionally white linen)

1. Introduction

Creative sewing is the hallmark of craftsmanship in sewing industry because it requires high set of skills and artistic instinct. Creative sewing involves various technique of stitching such as patchwork, quilting, applique, framework, paper piecing, and smocking. Generally, creative sewing designers / makers do not limit their work on clothing decoration but to various types of linen, home furnishings and accessories. The purpose of creative sewing is to add value to the products and exclusive creativity statement. The goal of creative sewing designer / maker surpasses monetary gain but more of personal accomplishment when their work is appreciated and become a family heirloom.

The wide acceptance of Malaysian public to online businesses has given great impact on creative sewing entrepreneur. Social media has become the main platform to showcase their products and services. Creative sewing entrepreneur has been given strong support from various government agencies as this trade is having the potential to generate income among housewives and improve their living standard.

The demand for creative related products is at rise and steadily growing as the result of new generation of consumers who appreciate exclusivity and bold in expressing themselves. Fashion statement is not limited to apparels but home furnishings as well. Therefore, career in creative sewing is promising because business owners are scouting for new talents in order to cater the existing and growing demands.

1.1 Occupational Overview

Creative sewing designers are typically employed either independently or for private businesses and design firms. They combine the skills of a seamstress with the talent and eye for design possessed by fashion designers. Day-to-day duties generally include designing, stitching, and constructing typical creative sewing products, according to the specific requests of a customer or manufacturer.

An artistic sense and textile skills alone are not enough to succeed in the industry. Creative sewing designers must have ability to thrive under pressure. They must be able to meet tight

deadlines, react quickly to changing demands, and be able to learn from critique while maintaining their individual style.

Interested individuals in this trade must possess strong sewing skills and an acute understanding of creative sewing design and production. They must keep abreast and familiarise themselves with fashion trends, sketch designs of creative sewing products, and various fabrics. Key skills also include attention to detail, creativity and the ability to communicate clearly with clients.

1.2 Justification and Rationale of NOSS development

This NOSS is an effort to upgrade the existing personnel with certification and acknowledge their set of skills in this trade. Currently, creative sewing products have garnered attention from the public who have exquisite taste for home furnishings and personal accessories. Most of creative designers in Malaysia are entrepreneur who involved in all work process of producing creative sewing products. These entrepreneurs have been widely acknowledged by event organisers and related government agencies to be involved in exhibition, promotional and sales activities. With the current shortage of skilled workers in the industry, the needs for structured training are essential as to respond to the growing demand for qualified and experienced workforce. Hence, the development of this NOSS is essential for the industry to have certain guidelines and standards based on the level of competencies that have been set by the industrial experts in this field.

1.3 Authority and Regulatory/Statutory Body Related to Industry

There is no specific authority that regulates this industry. However, the government is playing part via related agencies such as Perbadanan Kemajuan Kraftangan Malaysia, Institut Kraf Negara (IKN) and Jabatan Kemajuan Masyarakat (KEMAS) to promote the skills and products as well as training.

1.4 Occupational Pre-requisite

Based on the workshop findings, the minimum requirements set forth by the industry for any interested individual to undertake the job or career in this area are as follows:

- i. Basic sewing skills; and
- ii. Good eyesight without colour blindness.

Justification for Levels Shrinking and Areas Merging

Based on discussion among the industry experts, occupation for Level 1 and Level 2 are non-existent for two reasons:

- (1) Current development of the industry in which most of business structure is a small scale set-up and the production of creative sewing products are done by one personnel. It is a common practice in this trade, regardless the size of company, for a person to perform the roles of designer, seamstress, quality controller, and sales person. The nature of this trade started with a person's past time activity which developed into entrepreneurial ventures.
- (2) The definitions of competency levels for Level 1 & Level 2 do not reflect the roles and duties of creative sewing personnel. This trade requires a person to be competent in many aspects such as creativity, decision making, motor skills and artistic instinct. Therefore the entry level for creative sewing should start at Level 3.

4. Definition of Competency Levels

The NOSS is developed for various occupational areas. Candidates for certification must be assessed and trained at certain levels to substantiate competencies. Below is a guideline of each NOSS Level as defined by the Department of Skills Development, Ministry of Human Resources, Malaysia.

- Level 1: Competent in performing a range of varied work activities, most of which are routine and predictable.
- Level 2: Competent in performing a significant range of varied work activities, performed in a variety of contexts. Some of the activities are non-routine and required individual responsibility and autonomy.
- Level 3: Competent in performing a broad range of varied work activities, performed in a variety of contexts, most of which are complex and non-routine. There is considerable responsibility and autonomy and control or guidance of others is often required.
- Level 4: Competent in performing a broad range of complex technical or professional work activities performed in a wide variety of contexts and with a substantial degree of personal responsibility and autonomy. Responsibility for the work of others and allocation of resources is often present.
- Level 5: Competent in applying a significant range of fundamental principles and complex techniques across a wide and often unpredictable variety of contexts. Very substantial personal autonomy and often significant responsibility for the work of others and for the allocation of substantial resources features strongly, as do personal accountabilities for analysis, diagnosis, planning, execution and evaluation.

5. Award of Certificate

The Director General shall award, to any person upon completing successfully the NOSS program following skills level qualifications as stipulated under the National Skills Development Act, 652:

- Malaysia Skills Certificate / Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) Level 1, 2 or 3
- Malaysia Skills Diploma / Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM) Level 4
- Malaysia Skills Advanced Diploma / Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM) Level 5
- Statement of Achievement / Penyata Pencapaian (PC)

6. Job Competencies

The Creative Sewing Designing & Production Level 3 personnel are competent in performing the following core competencies:-

- a. Creative Sewing (Needlework)
- b. Creative Sewing (Smocking)
- c. Creative Sewing (Quilting)
- d. Creative Sewing Bag Making
- e. Computerised Embroidery Handling
- f. Artwork & Design Digitisation
- g. Creative Sewing Product Sales & Marketing

7. Work Conditions

The nature of this trade requires high level of perseverance and attention to details in completing work of art on product. Since creativity is subjective matter, criticism is regarded as a challenge to improve oneself. Personnel must be able to handle pressure and maintain composure in completing the work. Personnel must at all times comply with safety precautions and work procedure when handling sharp tools such as cutter, scissors, needles and sewing machine. Usually, personnel works between 8-10 hours a day; depending on the size / volume of the product, extra-hour is expected in meeting deadline.

8. Career Advancement

Experienced designers may advance to chief designer, design department head, creative director, or another supervisory position in which they oversee certain product lines or brands by a company. Some experienced designers may start their own company, develop designs, produce the products and sell them online or retail stores.

The following are examples of related occupations for creative sewing designers:

- Clothing designers create and help produce men's, women's, and children's apparel, including casual wear, suits, sportswear, evening wear, outerwear, maternity, and intimate apparel.
- Footwear designers create and help produce different styles of shoes and boots. As new materials become available, such as lightweight synthetic materials used in shoe

soles, footwear designers produce new designs that combine comfort, form, and function.

- **Accessory designers** design and produce items such as handbags, suitcases, belts, scarves, hats, hosiery, and eyewear.
- Costume designers design costumes for the performing arts and for motion picture and television productions. They research the styles worn during the period in which the performance takes place, or they work with directors to select and create appropriate attire.
